3.1 Gaming Grant Spending: (Tracy)				
was to spend all remaining gaming funds as well as the \$800 remaining in the reserved funds for outdoor playground equipment. (The reserved funds were raised approx. 8 years ago, so far we have only put some of the funds toward the storygarden). The plan was for Olwen to select natural playground equipment, then the PAC would order and pay before August 31st - the end of our fiscal year. There have been a number of issues with kids hanging out at the school in the evenings, so Olwen is concerned about possible theft or damage if we purchased the equipment that was planned. The equipment is free standing and is not secured. We need to agree on how to spend the required amount of gaming funds carrying over from previous years, or we will not qualify for the 2021/2022 gaminggrant. The new gaminggrant guidelines state that we have 3 years to spend the money. Taking this into account we have to spend at least \$8360.83 of our gaming funds before August 31st. We have already spent \$3297.43, so we still need to spend at least \$5063.40. It was noted that the \$75 BCCPAC membership fee can now be paid from the gaming account. Motion Passed.
