- Highlights of the **Superintendents Report** for March included:
- Childcare has now been embedded into MOE effective April 1st
- There will be an increase in ECE's in response to this change
- **Brigadoon at Chatelech Secondary Theatre—Fine Arts Students** was a big hit
- 4 Our own *Student Trustee* Matthew Douglas had a starring role
- 4 Spark 1 to Secondary offers 4 virtual sessions for parents whose children are entering HS
- Spring Break training was offered for CUPE Staff in a variety of professional development opportunities
- With the release of the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples Act (Declaration Act) Action Plan on March 30th. For SD46 this means we will be working alongside the **Ministry and indigenous Rightsholders** to address priorities & goals over the next 5 years (2022-27) which will focus on 13 Education specific outcomes. We are already ahead with Our Journey in Ensouling Our Schools & the Equity Scan. This enables us with deep roots & good position to begin the implementation process. SD46 Rocks!!

Sue's Committees & Attendance:

- I am now on the Food in Schools Committee Please take the opportunity to complete the upcoming survey the Committee is putting out in mid-April and let your voice be heard. I am excited about this committee and the opportunity to further improve food security for all students with the provision of good healthy, quality food for all students in our schools on the Sunshine Coast.
- I attended the Junior Firefighters Academy Graduation demonstration & ceremonies at the Sechelt fire Dept. compound at the beginning of April and was very impressed with the Cadets and graduates who are students of our SD46. Great job!
- I now sit on the Emergency Housing Committee and Affordable Housing for the Sunshine Coast as a SD46 Trustee Rep and they are working very hard as a committee to find viable solutions for this growing issue.
- The new Policing Committee will be meeting Quarterly as before and there are not many changes to the format with an opportunity for a round table to still bring concerns about policing issues. The RCMP has informed us that a Speed Watch program is being developed so we will look for that. That is one of the things on our wishlist.
- Notification of the *Transportation Committee* following a somewhat similar path is happening with the opportunity for Elected Officials to attend with concerns from constituents.

Talking Points:

- Trustees are happy to have the Covid restrictions loosening and allowing the students, staff and community more interaction.
- **Our Board** attended a Branch meeting and an Intergovernmental meeting, looking at issues in the community and across the branch area/zones as related to Education. We are excited for the possible collaboration and mutual benefit advocacy possibilities that are presented.
- Trustees are headed to our AGM with a motion that invites Equity as a lens to address governance pay across the province.
- **The Equity Scan Steering committee** met and the data collection and dissemination is in process from the first 11 questions, the next 11 questions have been chosen and the Committee is excited that there can be possible in person dialogues, circles, and possible focus groups to address the questions in depth.
