| 6.2 Treasurer's Report: Christine Hardt for Linda Shute <br> - Linda is away, she provided the following update via email: <br> - Cash Balance: $\$ 20,516$ (up $\$ 3,801$ from beginning of year) <br> - CIBC Operating Account Balance: $\$ 13,754.16$ <br> - Concession was from the BBQ: profit of $\$ 299$ (but lots of items leftover and some used for family dance) <br> - chicken fundraiser: profit of $\$ 425$ <br> - bulb fundraiser: profit of $\$ 384$ <br> - family dance: we made $\$ 1,812$ but no costs have been submitted yet <br> - big expenses include $\$ 3,000$ in payment to Ben for mural, $\$ 2,118$ for new popcorn machine, and $\$ 460$ for the kitchen cart <br> - Linda also noted that the donation letter should go out soon. | 6.3 Principal's Report: Barry Krangle <br> - Barry provided the following report and then left the meeting early due to a band rehearsal for the upcoming school concert. <br> - MiltMcLaren came to school recently to give a presentation.
